Move-In Day Tips

- Label everything!
- Pack items in cardboard boxes, Rubbermaid tubs, and <u>Ikea bags</u>
- Choose a different time slot from the roommate
- Rug first
- Headboards second
- Larger pieces next
- Cooler with drinks and snacks
- Stair-climbing dolly
- Good tool kit
- Extra clothes to change into after moving (It's a hot and sweaty day!)
