- the other two liberal arts selectives can be any liberal arts, including social sciences or humanities/fine arts; History, Literature, Foreign Languages, Philosophy, Religion, and either Art, Music, or Drama Appreciation (no more than three credits may be in appreciation courses).

BOLDED courses are the selective courses recommended by first year Pharmacy faculty.
